Dear Praying Friends,

Greetings in His matchless Name!

"To everything there is a season..." and I guess this is the "season" to bring you up to date on the roamings and blessings of the Fedena clan.

As most of you know we have made the *very difficult decision* to stop most "on the road" trips. We are trying to limit our speaking engagements to our supporting churches and to those not more than about a half an hour from our home. The good news is that our pastor (Louis Guarneri) allows me the opportunity to teach an adult Sunday School Class in our church (Straightway Baptist in Lawrenceville, NJ) and has also given me the privilege of preaching though the book of Ruth on Sunday nights when we are in town. I am nearing the end of that verse-by-verse series. This week I will be preaching on **Ruth 4:1-12**. The message is entitled: **"When Love Alone is Not Enough."** (read the passage, please)

Two weeks ago we took our annual trek to Cape May, N.J. to meet up with our dear friends brother and sister Herb & Marge Brail. While there I preached at the Rio Grande Bible Baptist Church. The pastor (Jeff McLeod) requested a message regarding our historic and biblical stand on being a Bible-believer and thus a fundamentalist and separatist. The message was entitled **"Why I Am A Bible Believer (Are YOU?)"**.

Each night (Sat. – Tues.) we took brother Brail's bunny (Miss Velvet) to a different location to help us pass out tracts. We have done this for several years with great results. Most everyone wants to pet *"the softest bunny in the world"* and each family received a Chick Tract *"This Was Your Life."* On Sat. night we went to the **Cape May** walking mall, on Monday night to **Ocean City** and on Tuesday night we hit the **Wildwood** boards ("Watch the tram car, please"). The end result was an opportunity to pass out several hundred tracts (one per family). We were usually surrounded with people wanting to pet the rabbit and would then thank us for the tract.

On Tues. night as we left the boardwalk about 10 PM, I pushed my wife in her wheelchair about a block and a half to my car. It was dark and I didn't see the raised sidewalk. The wheelchair hit the bump and Shirley flew out of the chair onto the concrete. She hit her head and started bleeding. Amazingly within 30-40 seconds (!) an off duty lifeguard showed up to help. He still had his first aid kit with him (!) so he stopped the bleeding, cleaned the wound, used some antibiotic cream and patched her up. To top it off he was from the country of Turkey and was only in Wildwood for the summer as a lifeguard!!! Maybe he was one of the *"angels unawares"* in Hebrews. Two young police officers also came by and asked if she wanted to go to the hospital. The lifeguard and I lifted her up from the sidewalk and got her back in her wheelchair. The police just stood and watched.

We left the shore on Wed. morning and returned home, then we drove about ½ hour to the Calvary Bible Baptist Church in Willingboro to preach in the Wed. evening service (Aaron McCullough is the pastor there). The messages in both churches were well received with numbers of believers at the altars.

Shirley is like the Energizer Bunny...she keeps on going and going. She is again doing physical and occupational therapy and it seems to really help her. Her diabetes numbers have been really good and she has only fallen once since we came home from the shore. She is still playing the piano at our home church and goes with me wherever I go. She still has daily bouts with severe pain from her Polymyalgia Rheumatica...usually twice each day. I am doing well overall with only the normal old age aches and pains. We appreciate your prayer support more than you can know and they are what keeps us going. Thank you so much!! Keep looking UP! It can't be much longer.
