Dear Partners in Ministry,

"I bring you good tidings of great joy, which shall be to all people" Luke 2:10

Merry Christmas from all of us Campana's! We would like the honor of sharing with you who pray and support this ministry some of the great things that our mighty God has done during the last three months. Back on October 6th I had the honor of preaching Alejandra Garcia's funeral, a faithful-Christian woman whose husband Martin I led to Christ about twenty years ago, in San Luis Potosi, Mexico. Praise God her sister-in law, Maria Socorro, was saved the next day in church. During the months of October and November our church held neighborhood Bible Clubs directed by our teenagers in three locations in the city of Juarez with 80-100 kids in attendance. A policewoman, Rosario, came to our church through this outreach and received Christ as her Savior. Last Tuesday I preached to the gospel to about 60 policemen. Guess who the commander was who gave me permission to preach? Rosario! During the week of October 17-19 our church participated in a City-Wide Revival Conference with ten other Fundamental Baptist Churches with over 350 people in attendance, great preaching and fellowship. The Lord gave me the privilege to lead two teenagers and an adult named Carlos Madrid to Christ. Later his Christian brother, Ricardo, told me that he had been praying for years for his brother's conversion. Hallelujah! During the month of November our family attended West Coast Baptist College so that our daughter Becky could see the college. Becky fell in love with the friendly staff and students and was challenged by the Bible classes. Please pray for this big decision in her life! Two faithful members of our church and myself continue to give out burritos and preach the gospel to several dozen inmates each Tuesday. Last Tuesday as I shared about Jesus' love for sinners, tears starting running down Christina's cheeks. She prayed to receive Christ, and thanked me for coming. Yesterday the Lord allowed 280 people come to our **Christmas Event** with eight adults receiving Christ. Lastly, a young married couple, **Carlos and Lucero Diaz** have come to work with our church with the prospect of turning the church over to them in the next six to nine months. Brother Carlos is a great preacher, soul winner and a hard worker, who has brought several people to church. His wife who studied music in Bible College is giving music theory and choir classes to our young people. He and his wife graduated from Bible College in San Luis Potosi last June, and Pastor Carlos was ordained to the ministry this past September. Please pray that the Lord would lead our family as to where we should plant, what would be the 4th church.


