## Safety Procedures and Guidelines

Due to the reduction of cases in our area and the easing of restrictions, we have revised the COVID guidelines for our church. By doing this, we are in no way stating that the threat of the virus is no longer applicable to our congregation. This virus is still around, and is still very dangerous. However, we feel that we can continue to reduce the risk of getting the virus with the following guidelines in place.

- Everyone will be required to wear mask upon entering and moving around in the building. Once stationary in a seat, the masks may be removed. Masks are available for those who need them.
- Service leaders will wear masks when they are not on the platform.
- Everyone will have their temperature taken. According to CDC guidelines, anyone 100.4 degrees or higher will not be able to attend.
- If you're showing any symptoms of coughing, sore throat, fever, shortness of breath, chills, muscle pain, headache, and new loss of taste and smell you will not be permitted into the building.
- We will have a touchless entrance and exit. Entrance and exit doors will be propped open.
- Hand sanitizer will be available throughout the building but we encourage you to bring your own.
- We will have limited, socially distanced seating. You no longer need to register for seating.
- The building will be sanitized before and after every service.
- We will not pass offering plates. Offerings may be given in the offering box at the rear of the auditorium or online at [JerseyShoreBaptist.com](http://JerseyShoreBaptist.com).
- Words for the congregational songs will be projected on the screens, but the hymnbooks will also be available.

We encourage anyone who is considered high risk, those with compromised immune systems, and those with underlying health issues, to continue to enjoy our online services and not attend services onsite during this time. Please pray for God to bless our services and to give safety to our entire church family.
