Safety Procedures and Guidelines

The following is a list of our church move-in guidelines. These guidelines are meant to help ensure that we present ourselves to the governor, local law enforcement, general public, media, and our church family, as having done more than what is required to ensure the safety of our church family during this time. It is very important that our church family follows the Safety Procedures and Guidelines. Those who choose to attend must understand that their compliance with our guidelines is necessary for the safety of others and the testimony of Jersey Shore Baptist Church. As of now our church will not have nursery, children's church, on-site Sunday school classes.

- **Our First Impressions crew will park vehicles according to social distancing guidelines.**
- **Everyone will be required to wear masks. We will have a table in the entrance with masks available for those who need one.**
- **Service leaders will wear masks when they are not on the platform.**
- **Everyone will have their temperature taken. According to CDC guidelines, anyone 100.4 degrees or higher will not be able to attend.**
- **If you're showing any symptoms of coughing, sore throat, fever, shortness of breath, chills, muscle pain, headache, and new loss of taste and smell you will not be permitted into the building.**
- **We will have a touchless entrance and Exit. Entrance and exit doors will be propped open.**

- **Hand sanitizer will be available throughout the building but we encourage you to bring your own.**
- **Please reserve seats for you (and your family) at JerseyShoreBaptist.com before attending the service.**
- **We will have limited, reserved, socially distanced seating.**
- **We will have restrooms available for emergency situations only. One person/family at a time will be permitted into a restroom; the restroom will then be cleaned before the next person will be permitted to enter.**
- **We will not pass offering plates. Offerings may be given in the offering plates located on the baptistry or online at JerseyShoreBaptist.com**
- **Words for the congregational songs will be projected on the screens. We will not use the hymnbooks.**
- **At the conclusion of the service, we will have an orderly dismissal; ushers will dismiss by row directing you to the nearest exit.**
- **We will not congregate in groups in the parking lot. Everyone will be asked to remain socially distanced while in the parking lot.**

We encourage anyone who is considered high risk, those with compromised immune systems, and those with underlying health issues, to continue to enjoy our online services and not attend services onsite during this time. Please pray for God to bless our services and to give safety to our entire church family.

COVID-19 is highly contagious and is known to spread mainly from person-to-person contact. By attending Jersey Shore Baptist Church, you agree to abide by the procedures established by the church to protect attendees and staff, and you voluntarily assume the risk that you and/or your family may be exposed to or infected by COVID-19 either at the church, in the church worship service, or in the nursery or Sunday School. You agree to assume all the risks of attendance and participation for you and your family, and you waive any liability against the church and any other parties.
